Open to me the gates of righteousness, that I may enter through them and give thanks to the Lord.

This is the gate of the Lord; the righteous shall enter through it.

Psalm 118:19-20

There are seven Sundays of Easter beginning with The Festival of the Resurrection of Our Lord. The stone had been rolled away, and Jesus had walked out alive having risen from the dead.

Psalm 118 is a messianic psalm describing events of Holy Week and what is now the completed work of Christ Jesus. The Messiah calls out to the LORD to open the gates of righteousness into His presence. And the LORD did that very thing.

With the betrayal of Judas, the denial of Peter, the fleeing of the others and the complete rejection and opposition of the religious leaders who should have welcomed him, Jesus placed his full trust in his Heavenly Father.


I thank you that you have answered me and have become my salvation. V. 21

This psalm, too, was a Passover psalm. It is possible that Jesus may have joined his disciples in worship with these words just hours before heading to the Garden of Gethsemane. His prayers there show Jesus' complete dependence on God the Father.

Verses 22-27 are the echoing words of the congregation sharing the Messiah's joy. And we are right to give God thanks and praise. "This is the gate of the LORD; the righteous enter through it." The barriers that kept us from God— our sin, Satan's schemes and death itself— have been torn down and removed through Jesus' death in our place and his resurrection to new life.

Our hearts may sing a new song all the weeks of Easter; indeed, our hearts may sing everyday because Jesus lives and makes his presence with us and brings us into the presence of God the Father clothed in the righteousness he has won for us.

Social Ministry: Absent. Approval of January Minutes. Motioned and approved. Old business: 1) Narcotics Anonymous wants to meet at 6:30-8:15pm on Saturdays. Would need storage for coffee supplies and binder. Duration still not known. Discussed possible member sponsor to help coordinate logistics; need lead to communicate with both NA and AA. Need to make sure the same privileges are afforded to both NA and AA. Motioned and approved to allow NA to use building. To notify office manager, custodian, and yard sale crew. Security issues to be reviewed. 2) Ministerial support position contract: Maximum 20 hours per month. Contract total to equate to \$5,400.00. Contact duration 9 months starting on February 19th.
